2006 Spring Official Enrollment

Hurricane Katrina forced the closing of Tulane University for most of the fall 2005 term. While there were a few limited classes held at remote sites in the area, there were no classes held on the university's main campus. Our students visited away at over 600 institutions during this period. Therefore, no formal enrollment figures will be published for fall 2005. For most reporting purposes, it is suggested that fall 2004 data be used. However, the official Spring 2006 enrollment counts are presented here for your information.
